A sari is a drape and a woman's garment in the Indian subcontinent.

It consists of an unstitched stretch of woven fabric arranged over the body as a dress, with one end attached to the waist, while the other end runs over one shoulder as a stole, sometimes being a part of the sari.

It may vary from 4.1 to 8.2 metres (13.3 to 27 yards) in length in breadth, and is a form of ethnic wear in Bangladesh, India, Sri Lanka, Nepal etc.

There are various names and styles of sari manufacture and draping, the most common being the Nivi style.

The sari is worn with a fitted blouse also called a choli (saree or kuppala in southern India, and choli in Nepal) and a petticoat called guppa, patta. It remains fashionable in the Indian subcontinent today.
